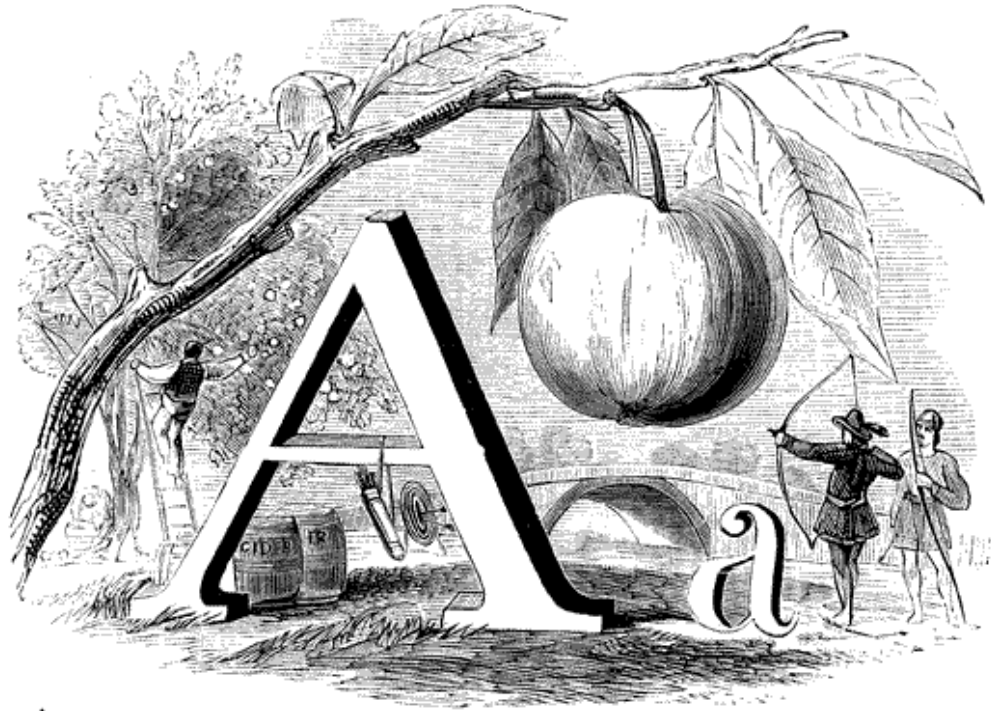

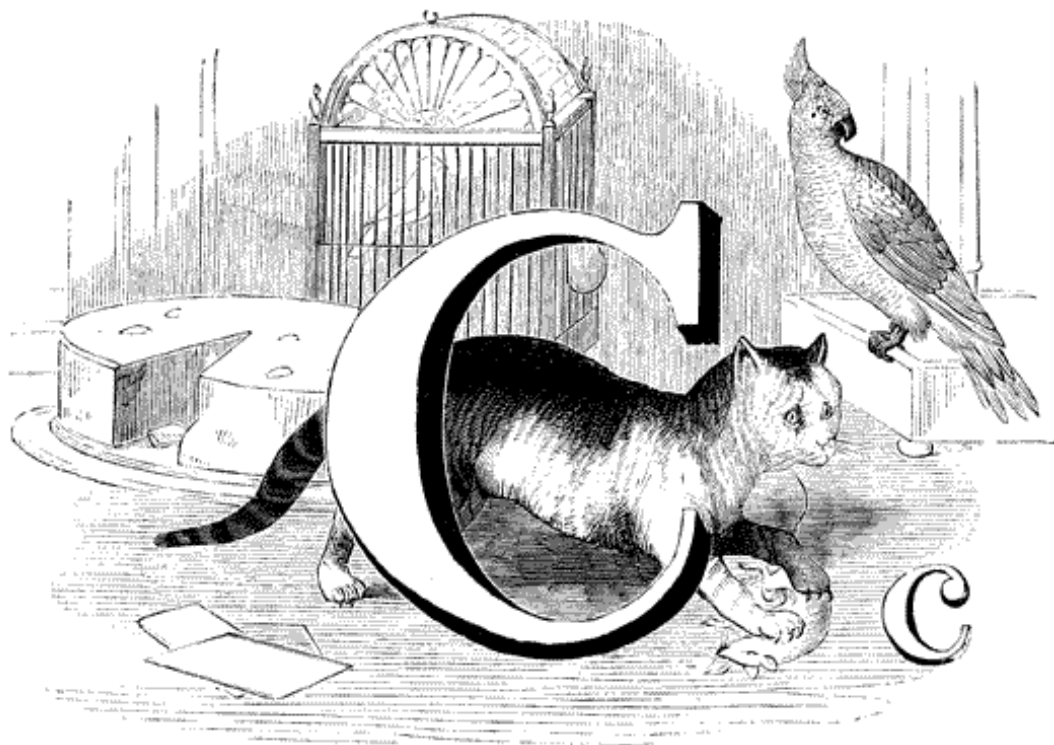
A stands for Apple, which here you may see.

There are four objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter A. Can you point them out?



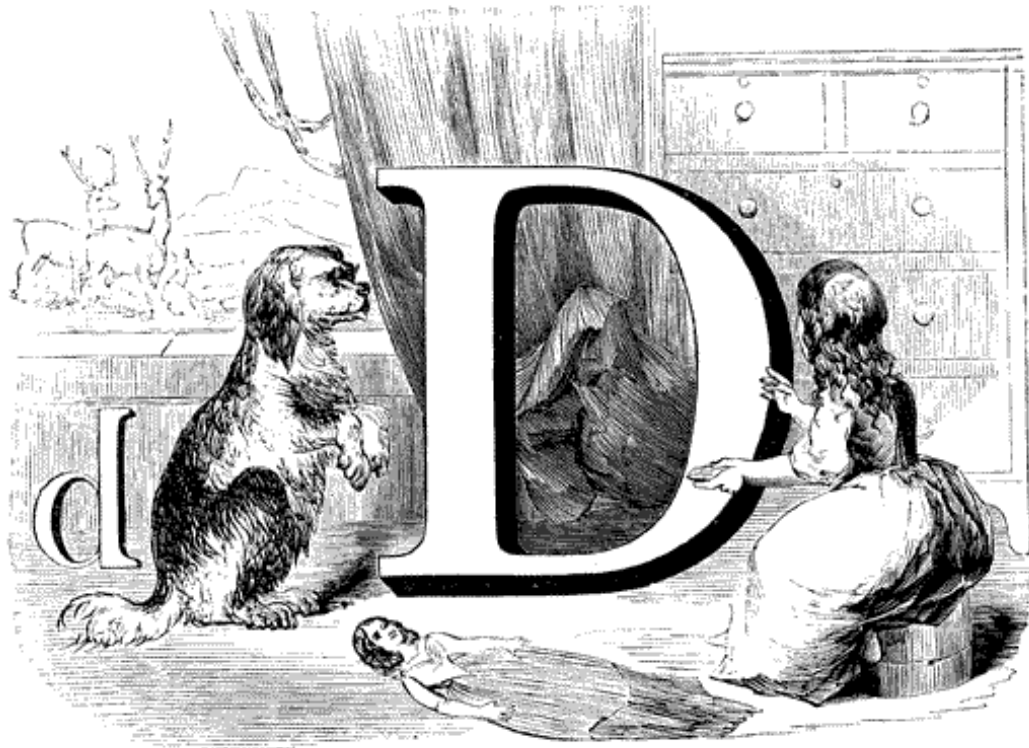
B is for Ball, as round as can be.

There are nine objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter B. Can you point them out?



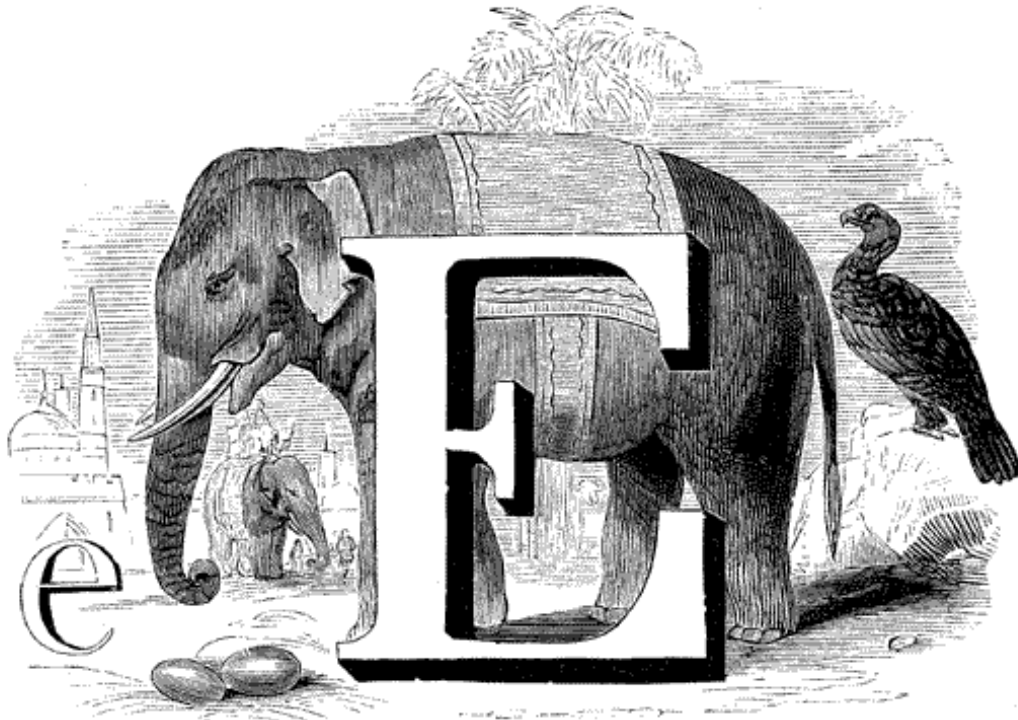
C begins Cat, and Carpet, and Cup.

There are five objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter C. Can you point them out?



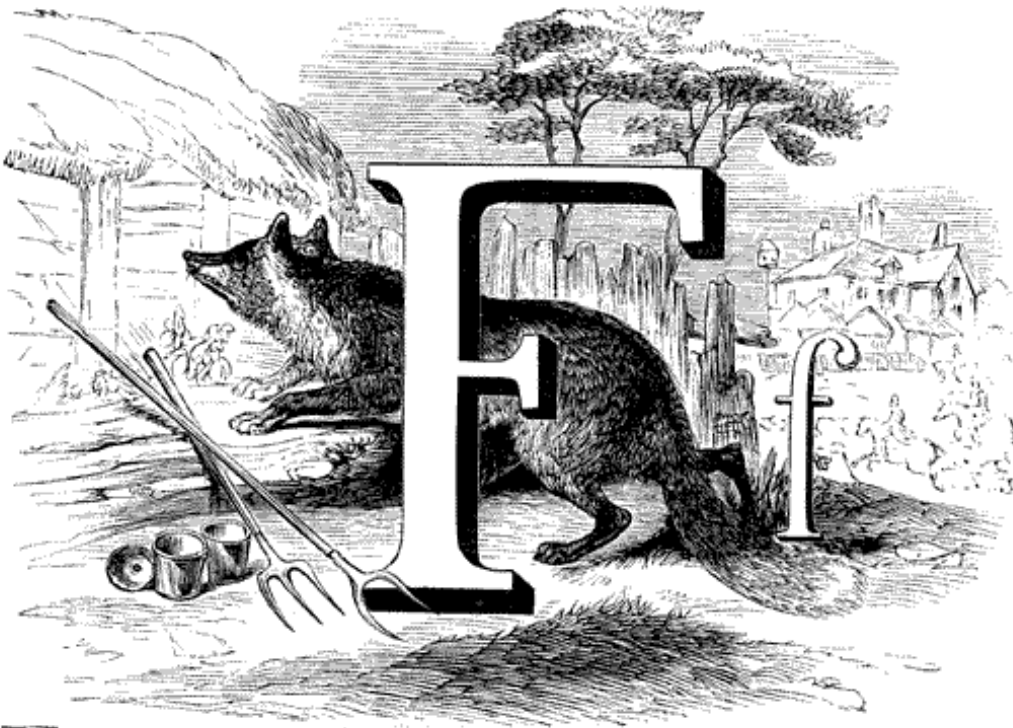
D is for Dash, who nicely sits up.

There are three objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter E. Can you point them out?



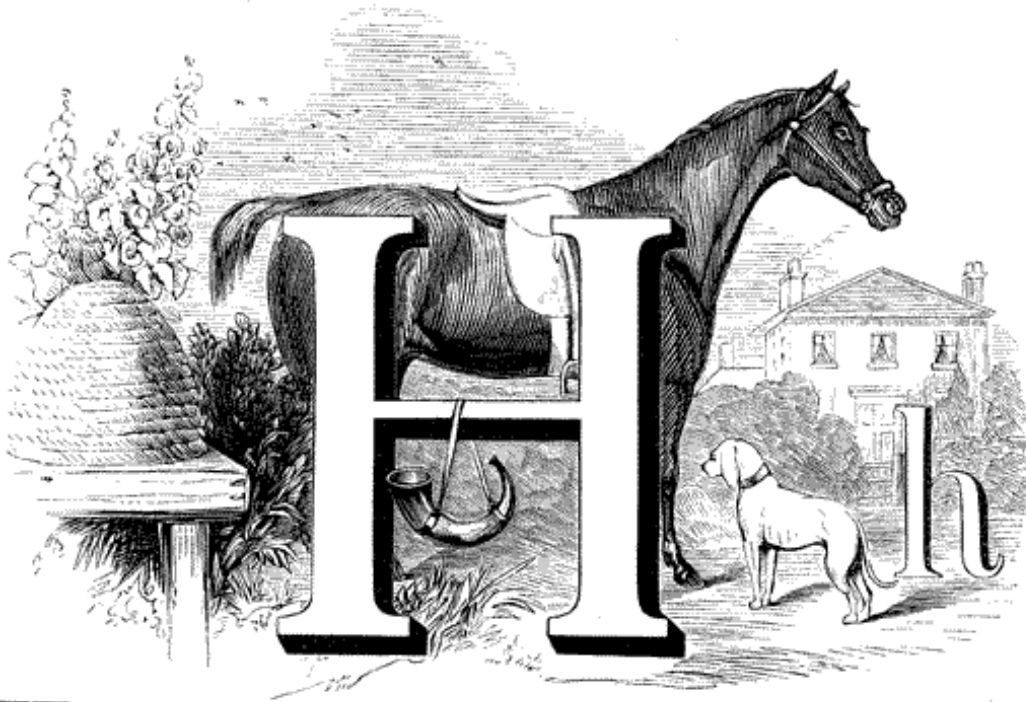
F begins Fox, and we know he is sly.

There are three objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter I. Can you point them out?



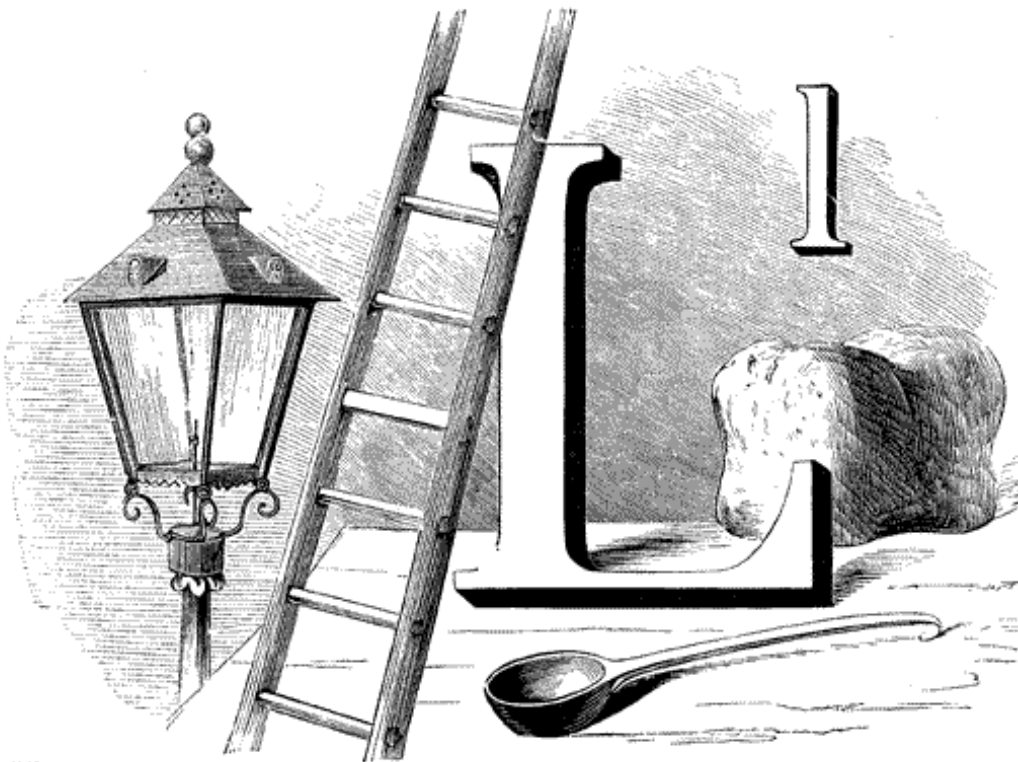
J is a Jug, to hold water or milk.

There are four objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter N. Can you point them out?



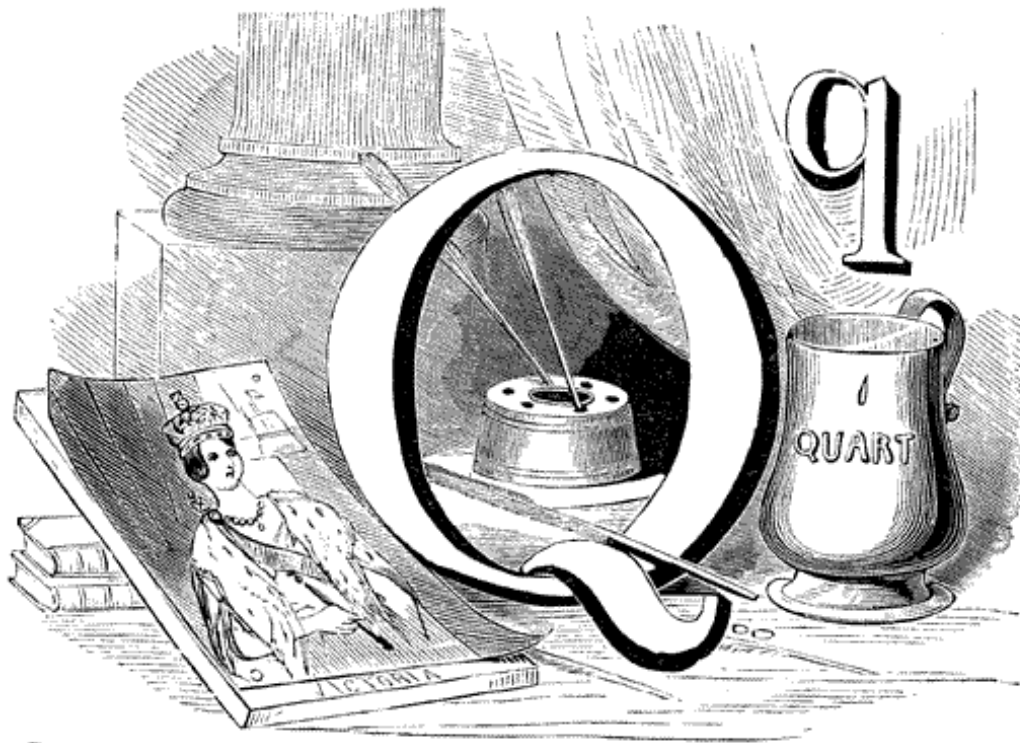
O stands for Owl, that eats mice for its prey.

There are four objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter O. Can you point them out?



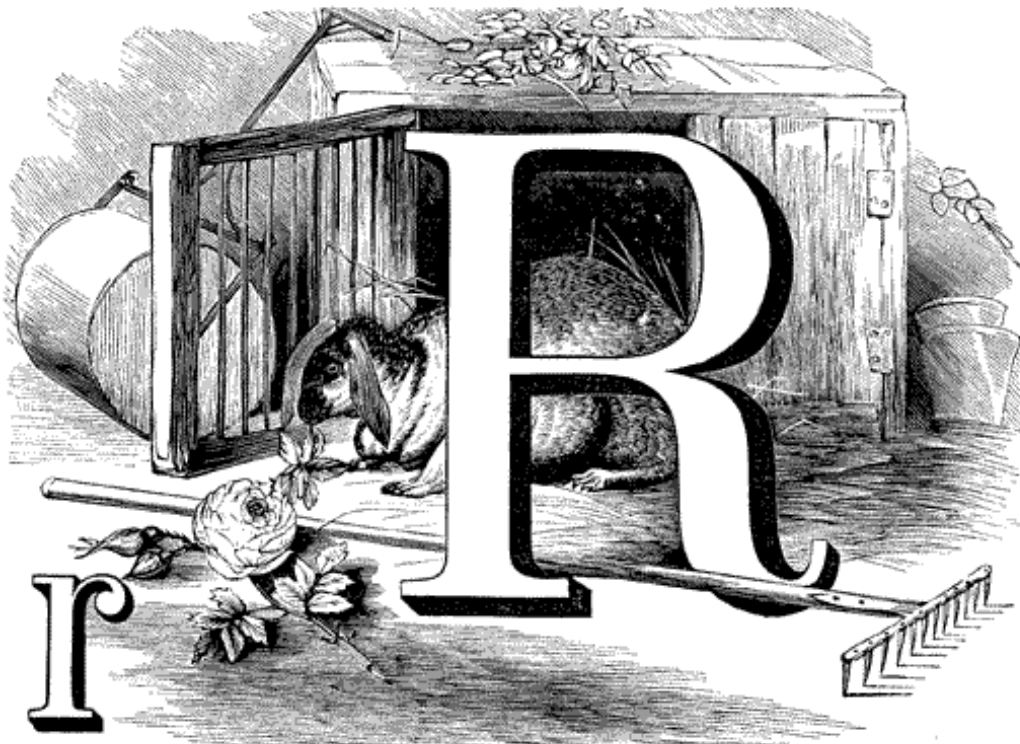
P stands for Parrots, the green and the gray.

There are eight objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter P. Can you point them out?



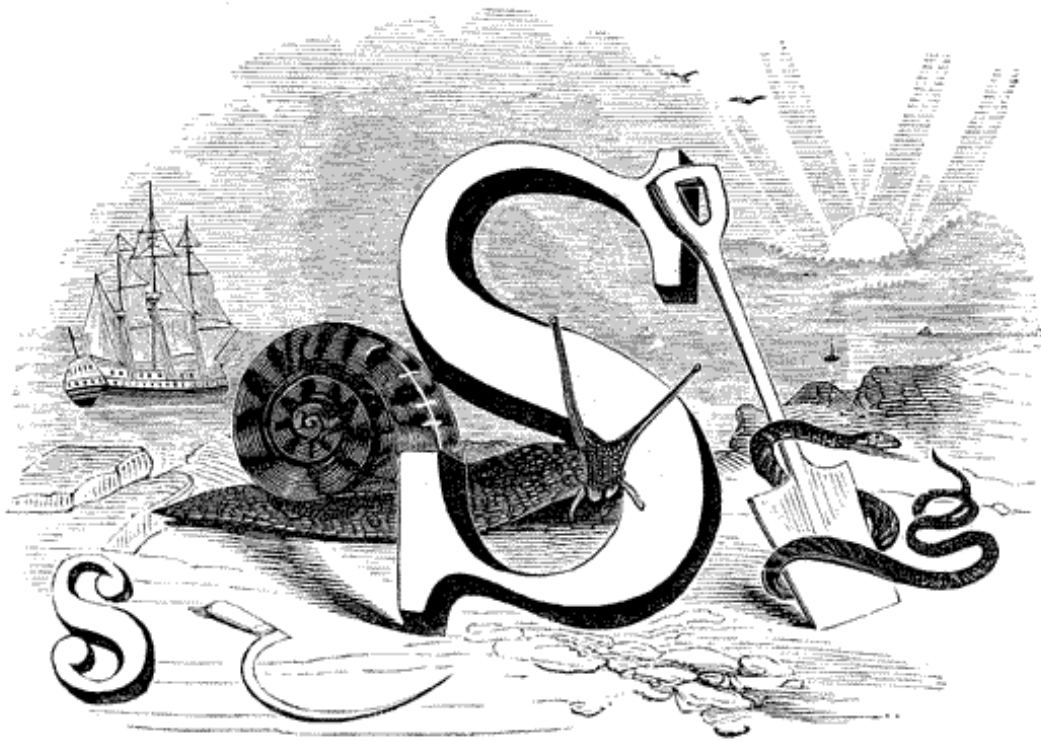
Q stands for Quills, from the Goose or the Swan.

There are three objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter Q. Can you point them out?



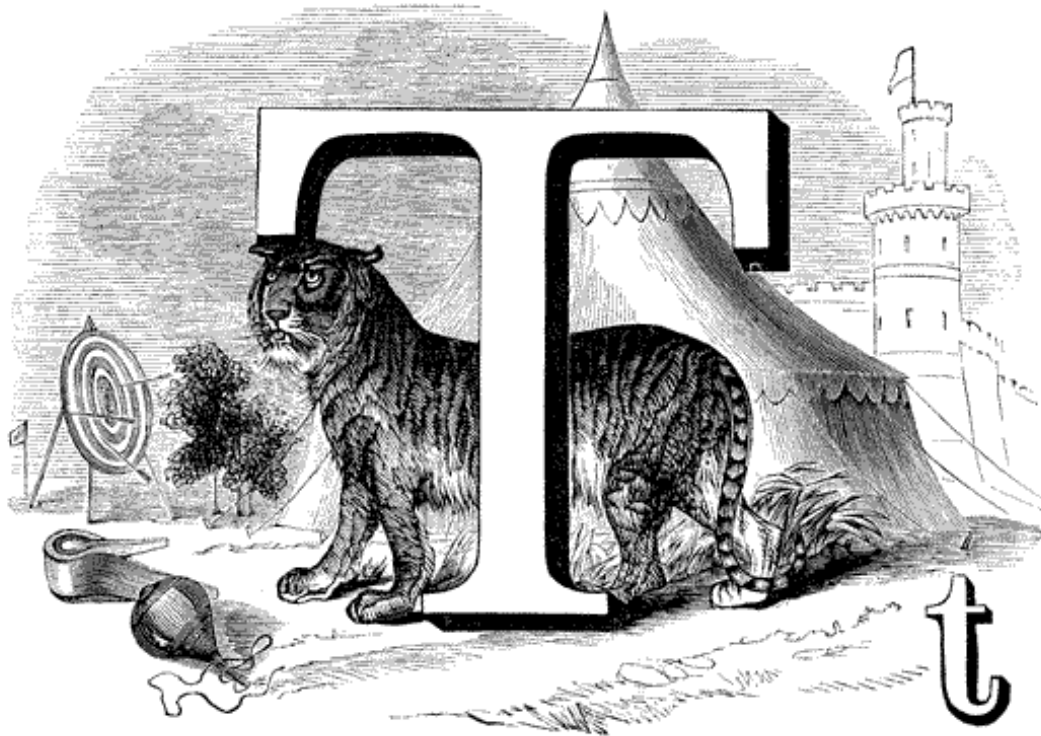
R stands for Rabbit, belonging to John.

There are four objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter R. Can you point them out?



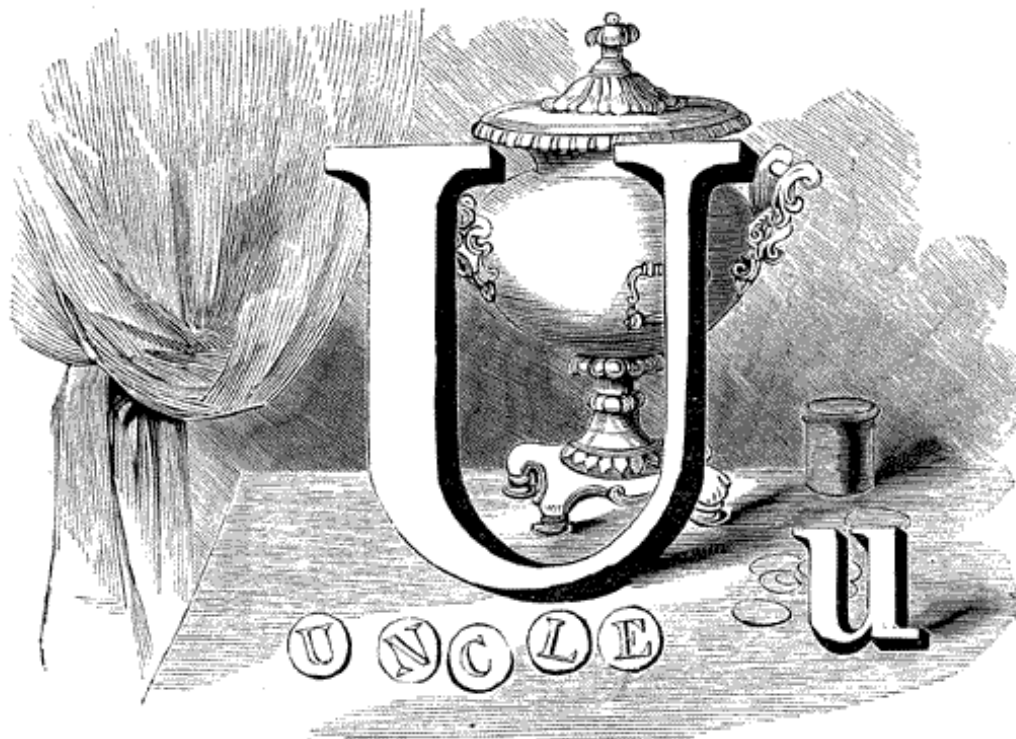
S stands for Snail, with its house on its back.

There are eight objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter S. Can you point them out?



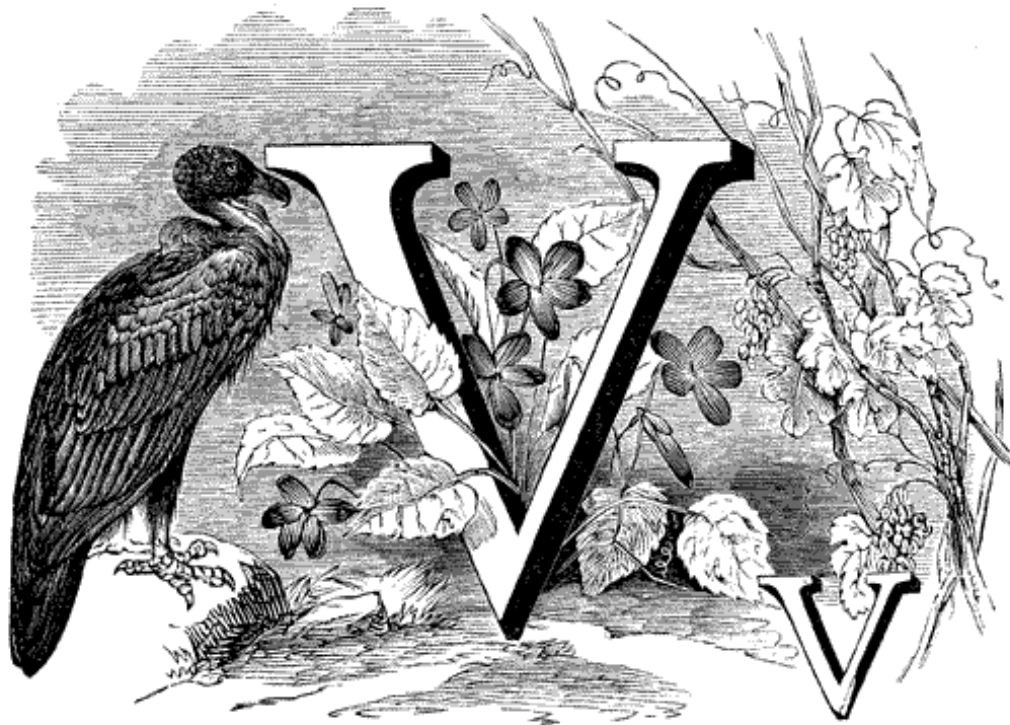
T stands for Tiger, striped yellow and black.

There are six objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter T. Can you point them out?



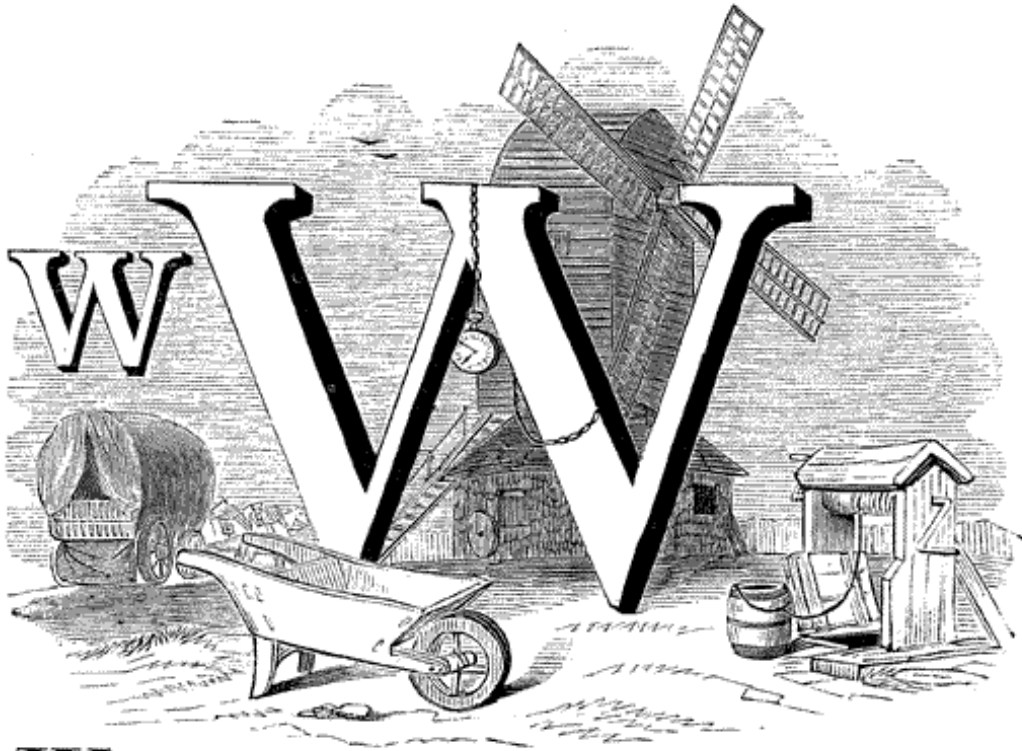
U stands for Urn, to hold water for tea.

Can you think of an animal whose name begins with the letter U?



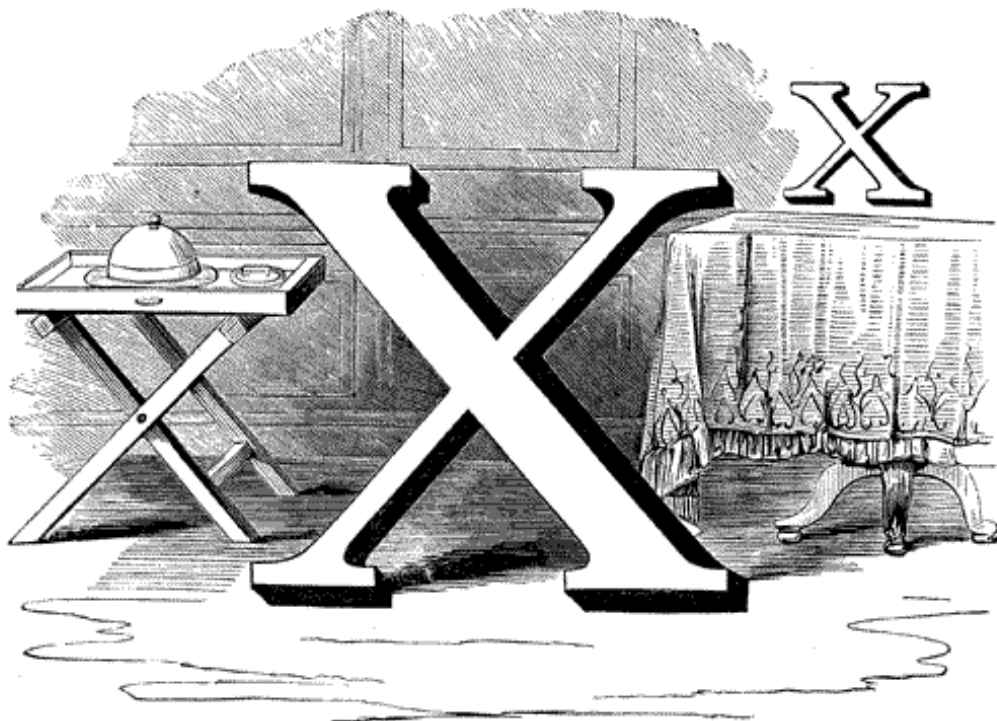
V is a Violet, which here you may see.

There are five objects in this picture, the names of which begin with the letter W. Can you point them out?



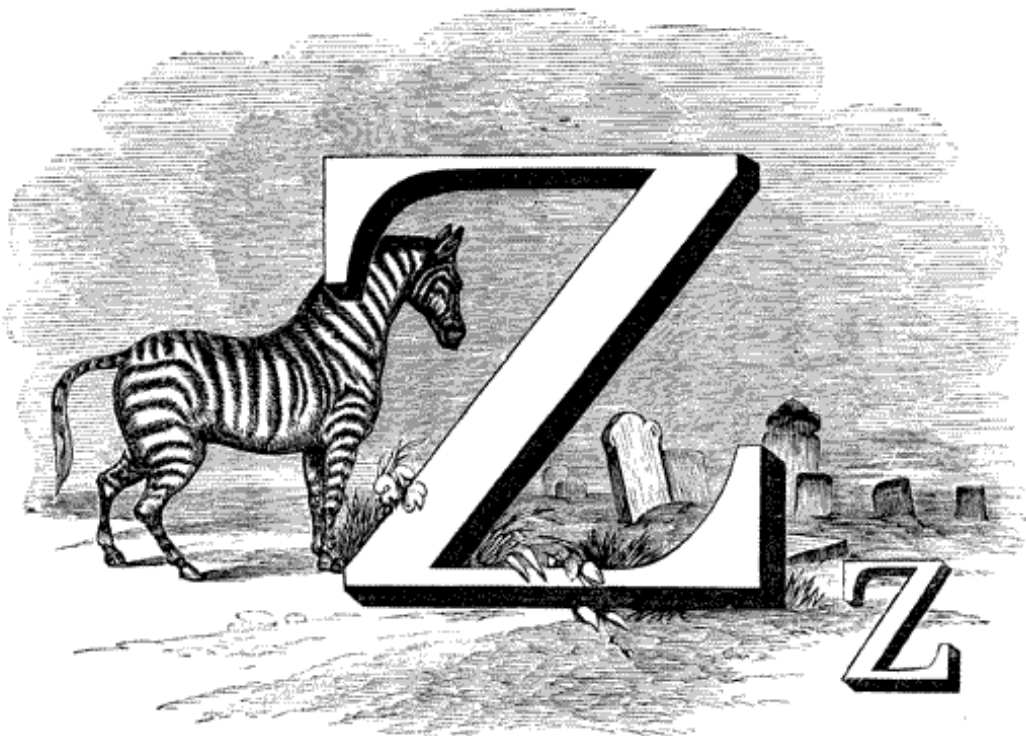
X is a letter, like this X, you will find.
